

ORDER OF WREATH LAYING CEREMONY

The order of the proceedings is varied this year, as the Wreath Laying Ceremony will follow the two minute silence. This removes any time constraints so those laying wreaths may approach the War Memorial individually, rather than in pairs as in previous years. The Wreath Laying Ceremony will be followed by the Remembrance Service in Sherborne Abbey. Organisations will have ordered their own wreaths for Remembrance Sunday through the Royal British Legion Appeal Organiser **Mr Andrew Norton** on 07769407130.

For the information of organisations who may be participating in the ceremony, wreaths will be laid in the **following order** on **Sunday 14th November 2021** commencing at approximately **11.05am** (following the 2 minute silence, Reveille and the recitation of the Kohima Epitaph). The ceremony will take place at the Memorial Cross, Half Moon Street, Sherborne. If you are unable to lay your wreath for any reason, it would be appreciated if you would contact the Parade Marshal, **Steve Neish** (work number **01935 389000** or email steve@parkfc.co.uk) prior to the event, so that untimely breaks in the wreath laying ceremony might be avoided.
